- **Homework Assignments:** All homework assignments are due at the beginning of the next class. Assignments submitted in time will be graded for credit. [3 points = all questions are completed and checked prior to class, 2 points = 90% or higher is completed and checked prior to class, 1 points = 75% or higher is completed and checked prior to class, plus 1 point for correct heading and format. 1 point for taking notes on flipped teaching] **Test:** (100pt-scale) A test is based on one or more chapters, and the date will be announced. **Quiz:** (30pt-scale or less) A quiz is based on a portion of a chapter (or small chapter) The date may NOT necessarily be announced. Missed quiz grade will be replaced with equivalent % point of the same chapter. **Project:** Any take-home assignments and/or projects deemed "major" will be considered as a part of assessment grade. **Final:** It consists of cumulative multiple-choice questions, and may include some open-response questions.

Weight Grading System

Assignments (home-work or in-class) 10%, Assessments (test, quiz, pop-quiz, etc.) 75%, Cumulative & Final Exams 15%,
